

Dear members of St Michael's,

You may well know that our church is considering **employing a Families Minister**, to take on a role of leading and coordinating our ministry and mission to families, parents and children.

We feel that commissioning **someone with particular skills** in this area of ministry would help our church, as we try to share faith and fellowship with young families in the challenging context of today's society.

A Working Party is developing this proposal and will be **submitting a plan** to the Church Council (PCC) on 16 September, seeking the PCC's agreement to move forward towards an appointment.

A number of parishioners have **welcomed this project**, and said that they would be prepared to to **donate specific funding** towards employing the Families Minister, if an appointment is made.

We would like to see if there may be other members of the church able and willing to help fund this post, and prepared to **offer a pledge to do so** at this stage.

Although the PCC have already allocated funds towards this post, there will be **a funding gap** which we are looking to fill in this way. Indeed, the level of salary we can offer, and the hours we can employ someone, both aspects will affect the **numbers and quality of potential candidates**, will be determined in part by the generosity of individual members of the congregation.

If **donating towards this specific project inspires you**, please could you consider what you would feel able to pledge, on a monthly basis. We are planning for **an appointment to run for up to five years**, to make a significant impact, so pledges need to be sustainable, God willing, over that period.
