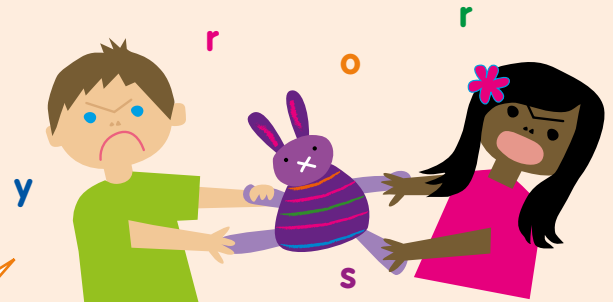

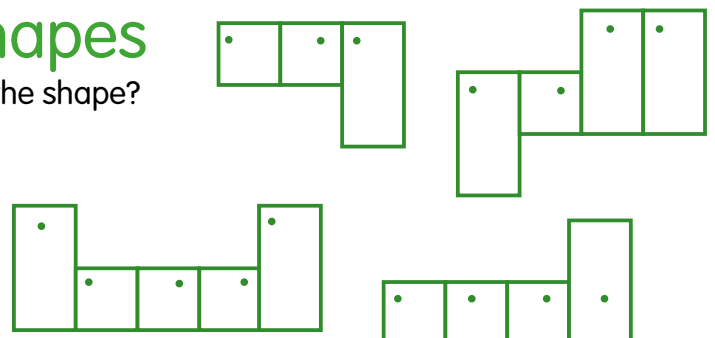

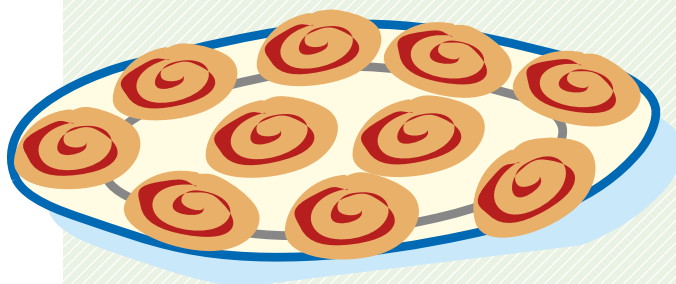

John told the people how to live as God asks. Find some words that describe how God wants us to live. Start with **L** and choose every other letter.



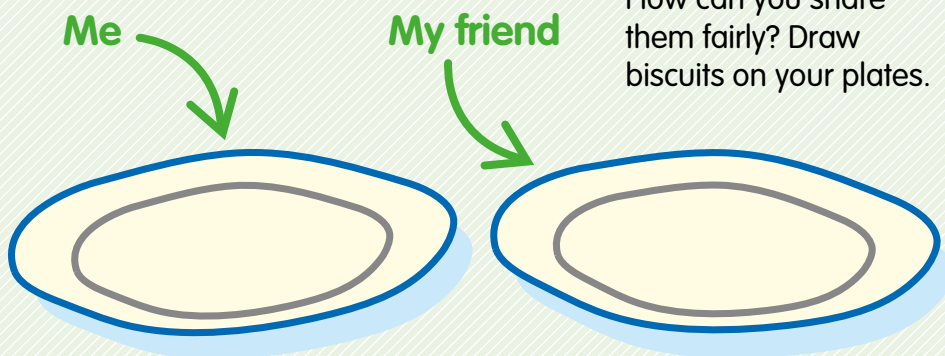
The people asked John the Baptist how to do what God wants. John the Baptist tells them to be fair. God wants us to share our things.

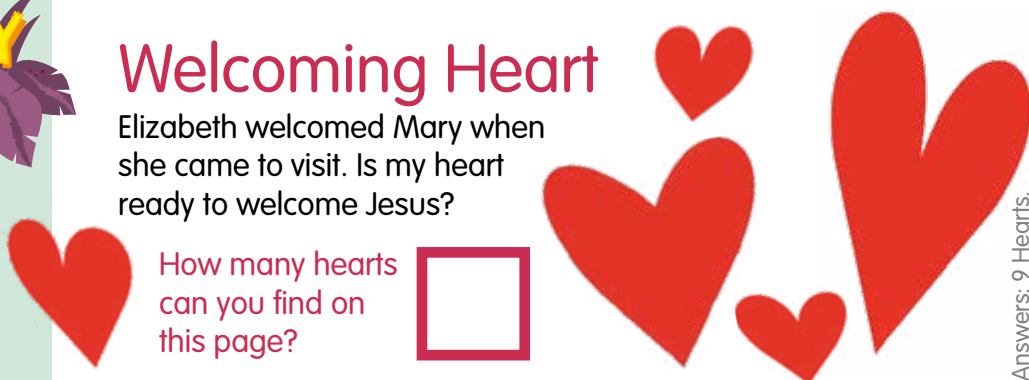
A PRAYER TO SAY
