#### **Our Work**

We aim to care for, listen to, and help people in our community. Sometimes that's just a friendly wave and a smile, sometimes it's a longer chat or some practical help.

Usually, we are out and about in the towns of Bishop's Stortford and Sawbridgeworth in the evenings, stopping by the pubs, restaurants and train stations.

We can stop and chat to those who are lonely or worried, offer help and directions to those trying to find a way home, support those a little (or a lot) worse for drink or drugs.

We don't evangelise (unless invited to do so.) We just try to do what Jesus would do; to care for others, without judgement.

### How you and your Church can support Street Pastors

We want EVERY Church in Bishop's Stortford, Sawbridgeworth and surrounding villages to be involved in our work. **Most of all, we need your prayers.** We ask that you cover our work in prayer; in your services, your house groups and in your homes.
